RACE FORMAT

Practice

- Each class will receive a two (2) lap practice session prior to racing.
- Practice order will follow the race order unless advised otherwise.

Heats

- All classes will compete in 3 - 5 heat races.
- Heat races will be 3-4 laps in duration.
- Heat positions will be used to determine points and/or grid positions for finals if applicable.

Finals

- Finals will be run for each class where there is two (2) or more heats per round.
- Finals grid positions will be determined by heat race results.
- Finals results determine overall placings for the day.
- Finals will be 4 laps.

GENERAL RULES

- All riders must hold a current competition licence.
- Rider's briefing is mandatory for all competitors.
- Full protective riding gear must be worn at all times on track.
- All motorcycles must pass scrutineering before competing.
- No riding in pit areas.
- Enclosed footwear at all times in the pits. NO Crocs.
- Unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for junior riders at all times.
- Any protests must be lodged in accordance with club rules.
- Safety is the priority – racing may be stopped at any time.
- Do NOT enter the track while bikes are on the track to attend to a fallen rider.

SEASON RULES

Best five rounds count toward championship.

Tiebreaker:

- Most wins
- Most seconds
- Best final round result

Minimum rounds required to qualify: 5

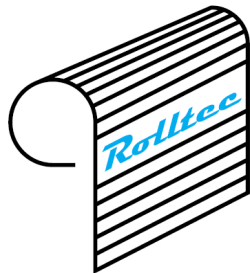

TRACK & SAFETY INFORMATION

- Designated pit and spectator areas must be respected.
- No unauthorised access to start or track areas.
- First aid personnel are present throughout the event.
- Emergency procedures will be explained at riders briefing.



CLUB DAY 2 – GRIDS

Please Note:

It is the primary responsibility of the Rider, Parent, or Guardian to ensure they are competing in the correct Class, Heat, and Gate draw.

Key Responsibilities and Penalties

Failure to follow these requirements typically leads to the rider being disqualified or not scored for that specific race.

Class Verification: Riders must ensure their machine and grading align with the entered category. Entering the wrong class without proper endorsement can lead to exclusion.

Heat & Gate Draw: It is the competitor's duty to be aware of their specific heat and grid position (gate draw) before each race.

Junior Riders: For competitors under 18, the Parent or Guardian shares legal responsibility for ensuring the rider is in the correct position and using the correct equipment, such as a charged and properly mounted transponder.

Race Day Compliance

Riders' Briefing: Attendance is compulsory for all riders (and a parent/guardian for those under 18). Any rider who fails to attend may be fined or penalised at the discretion of the Steward.

Grid Delays: Creating an unnecessary delay on the grid because of being in the wrong position can result in being sent to the rear of the grid or receiving a time penalty.

Official Discretion: While officials can exercise judgment to ensure fair play, they generally enforce scoring penalties if a rider's presence in the wrong heat or gate draw disrupts the competition or provides an unfair advantage.

Race Report: 2026 Australian Dirt Track Championships – Albury Wodonga

The recent Australian Dirt Track Championships showcased a highly competitive field, with several riders from the Mike Hatcher JMCC delivering strong performances across multiple classes.

The event was held on a “gater’s track,” where race outcomes were heavily influenced by starting performance. With limited passing opportunities and a narrow racing line, the majority of races were effectively decided at the drop of the gate. As a result, rider reaction time, clutch control, and launch execution proved critical to success.

MHJMCC Rider Results

Cooper Quinn emerged as a standout performer, claiming victory in the 9–13 65cc titles. His consistent and effective starts allowed him to control races from the outset, capitalising on the track conditions. He created a bit of history winning back-to-back Australian Champion moving up an age group in his first attempt from 65cc 7-9yrs and doing it again in 65cc 9-13yrs Australian Junior Dirt Track Championship. This in its own, gives #cooperquinn82 x 6 Australian Junior Champion Titles in a row.



Bailey Brookes delivered an impressive ride in the 100cc to 150cc 2-Stroke final, securing 2nd place. Competing in a higher-capacity category, Bailey demonstrated strong pace and competitive starts throughout the event. In the 200cc to 250cc 4-Stroke final Bailey had his worst gate all weekend and finished 8th. In the 85cc 2-Stroke & 150cc 4-Stroke 12-U16 Final Bailey came away with another podium edging out North Brisbane rider Henry Nicholls.



Kai Brookes in his first major meeting, managed to make the final and finished 8th, putting in a solid performance in what was a tightly contested field where small margins at the start made significant differences in final positions.

Kru Tulloch was unfortunate to be involved in a crash in the 9–13 65cc Final and was unable to recoup for the restart but managed to work his way from last off the start back to 6th. He achieved a podium finish with a 3rd place in the 85cc 9–13 class. His consistency and ability to execute under pressure were key factors in securing a top three result.

Reagan Quinn took out the 65cc 2-Stroke 7-U9, **Hudson Raffin** rode great in his first title race to finish 5th and **Lachlan Webber** made the final and finished in 12th. **Hudson McConnell** rode well all weekend and finished 4th on the 65cc 9-13, 6th on the Mod and a great ride on the 85cc also finishing in 6th. **Jaxx Knapman** after being off the scene for a while placed 4th on the Mod narrowly missing a podium. **Beau Neumann** grabbed a 3rd place ahead of Reagan Quinn in 4th place in the 50cc Auto Division with Lachlan Webber close behind in 5th place.



85cc 2-Stroke & 150cc 4-Stroke – Girls saw **Rubii Ward** and **Francesca Todd** proudly represent MHJMCC and both battled hard to make the finals finishing in 6th and 8th. In the 100cc to 150cc 2-Stroke & 200cc to 250cc 4-Stroke – Girls **Rubii Ward** rode the wheels off the bike but on a track with limited passing opportunities she just couldn't find a way past and just missed out on a podium finish coming home in 4th.

Event Summary

Overall, the championships highlighted the importance of starting proficiency in dirt track racing, particularly on tracks that limit overtaking opportunities. MHJMCC riders demonstrated strong technical skills and race craft, with multiple podium finishes and championship wins reinforcing the strength and quality of riders from the club.

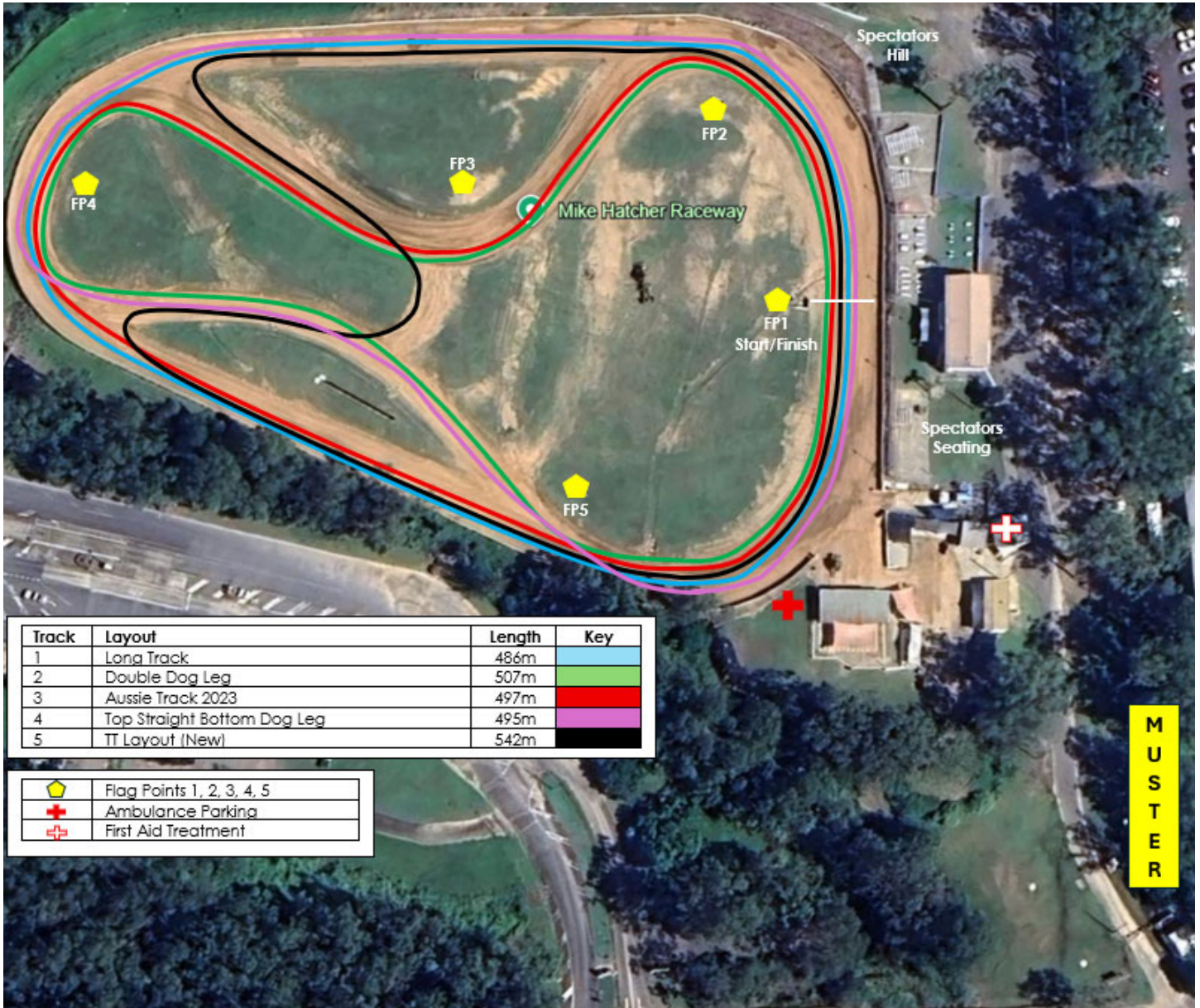
